



## Radical COVID-19 Safety Precautions

---

### Gathering Guidelines

- Social Distancing
  - Maintain 6 ft between anyone other than family members.
  - Masks must be worn by all participants throughout the duration of the gathering.
  - Meetings will occur in spaces most suitable for social distancing.
- Phase 3 Gatherings
  - Meetings in groups of 10 or less in each room while following the social distancing regulations will be permitted.
  - Designated groups of 10 or less will gather in specified areas at an assigned time & room within the church building.
  - These small groups will replace Zoom gatherings and allow for more personal interaction as they share a game, video lesson, and discussion time together.
  - No singing during gatherings to prevent spread of airborne germs.
  - No unsealed snacks or food will be offered.
- Phase 4 Gatherings
  - Meetings in groups of 50 or less in each room while following the social distancing regulations will be permitted.
  - Our full Radical group of 50 or less will gather in a specified area in an assigned room within the church building during our usual gathering times.
  - Potential for singing with facial coverings to be permitted during these gatherings. We will give an update as this stage comes as to our plan for this.
  - No unsealed snacks or food will be offered at this point either.
- Phase 5 Gatherings
  - Radical gatherings will be able to resume join our usual gathering spaces and format without added health guidelines or social distancing regulations!

## Cleaning Measures

- Surfaces
  - Participants are encouraged to bring their own bottle of hand sanitizer.
  - We will also provide bottles for general use at any gathering.
  - We will also have extra masks, provided that a student does not have one when they arrive at a meeting.
  - Surfaces, such as chairs, tables, etc. will be sanitized before and after every meeting.
- High-Touch Surfaces
  - Objects such as door handles, bibles, sign-up sheets, game items, collection jars, etc. will either be cleaned periodically during meetings or not used until such phases as it is deemed safe to do so.

## Confirmed Exposure

- In the event that there is a Radical participant who has a confirmed COVID-19 case, our team will take the necessary action to communicate this with church leadership and public health officials, close the affected meeting spaces until they are properly sanitized, and communicate with all those who may be affected.
