Date: Still in Paul's imprisonment in Rome, early 60's

Audience: the church at Colossae, another gentile majority church

Reason: Again, to correct some of the false teachings of who Jesus was, especially the deity of Jesus.

Theme: Our fullness is in Jesus

Key Verse:

Colossians 2:9–10 CEB

All the fullness of deity lives in Christ's body. And you have been filled by him, who is the head of every ruler and authority.

Sections: Fullness of Christ (Ch 1-2), New Life in Jesus (Ch 3-4)

Key Words: Fullness, Wisdom, Knowledge, Faith **Basic Intro**: Much like Philippians, Paul is hearing second hand of the trouble in a church and he is using his authority and writing skills to re-direct people back onto a good path.
