# PASTOR'S CORNER

Thoughts, dreams, and ramblings of someone who just wants to connect you to Jesus



I want to start off with gratitude. I am ever so thankful to the church for all that has been done to help while I was on renewal leave. It has always been the entire church together that has made the work of the church able to be accomplished. So for all those who came to preach, those who did extra liturgical work, those who helped with the little things that come up each week and those who finished our preparations for painting... THANK YOU!

We will spend the first two weeks of August with me finishing up our sermon series of Summer in the Psalms. Following that series, we will enter into a fun and different sermon series based off of the work of the mini-series Ted Lasso.

#### "Believe"

Later this month, I will begin a new series of sermons based on some quotes from the fictional TV character and series, "Ted Lasso." Ted Lasso is the story of a semi-successful, mid-level college football coach in the USA who is surprisingly hired as the new manager (coach) of the Richmond Football (soccer) Club in England. It's a classic "fish out of water" trope that is compelling because of Coach Lasso's intentional and genuine optimism.

To be completely honest, I was initially hesitant to offer this series. The TV show tells a great story and has compelling characters and there is much to like about it. At the same time, it is not "Christian programming," as it contains adult language and adult situations that are not appropriate for all audiences. I felt a little strange about using such a show for illustrative purposes, even though we will not be showing any video clips in worship. But sometimes God speaks to us through the secular world. And other times, finding common ground in the secular world can help the Church reach people who might not otherwise be interested in what the Church was doing.

It is entirely up to you whether or not you watch the show. You will not need to watch the show in order to understand the sermons. I'm planning to share a few of Ted Lasso's best one-liners and use them as the starting point for sermons that are aimed at helping us be better and stronger disciples of Jesus Christ. I'm calling the series "Believe" based off of his poster that inspires the team just when they need it.

My prayer is that God speaks to us in powerful ways. I also hope you will invite a friend to meet you here for worship during this series.
